We are so appreciative of Chuck offering this gift during this tender time.

On Tuesday, February 27nd our Staff Parish Relations Committee (SPRC) met and discerned a process for searching for our next leader of Student Ministries. *SPRC created a search committee to lead this effort, chaired by Bobbi Sanders.* Bobbi is both a member of SPRC and an active mentor in our student ministry. Please keep this team in your prayers.

The search team's first order of business will be to gather our youth, youth leaders, parents, and staff to listen to their hopes for this position.
